IMPORTANT Red Pine members have priority for entries and stabling.

Contact melissamae33@hotmail.com or text Missy 763-350-9237 to reserve stabling.

VACCINATIONS & COGGINS: All horses must have a negative Coggins within the past 12 months and flu/rhino vaccination within the past 6 months (but not less than 2 wks before show date). You must upload your Coggins and vaccines into Horse Spot or pay \$5 office fee.

RIDER WAIVERS: All riders must check into the office before riding and sign an RPHSA waiver.

ENTRIES close September 12th, or before, if full. Any late entry accepted after September 12th will be charged late fee, if space allows. ***Upon horse's entry being accepted, a non-refundable \$50 deposit will be charged to the credit card on file.*** The remaining balance can be paid at end of horse show with cash, check or credit card.

SCHEDULE

THURSDAY Move-in available any time after 10am. Schooling available until 7pm.

SCHOOLING BEFORE SHOW EACH DAY- Rings are open at 6am and will close 30 min before classes begin.

SCHOOLING AFTER EACH SHOW DAY- please check with Management for available schooling times on Friday/Saturday.

**SHOW MGMT RESERVES RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY AND ADJUST SCHEDULE AS NEEDED AND BASED ON*

ENTRIES* REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from the national federation, a competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior at a competition or towards its management, which management is able to substantiate, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a competition which management is able to substantiate.

SHOW RINGS & LUNGING

Four show arenas: (1) **Main Hunter** sand outdoor ring, (2) **Upper Hunter** sand outdoor ring; (3) **Pavilion** sand outdoor ring; and (4) **Jumper** sand outdoor ring.

Lunging is permitted in sand ring behind stabling. Please do not lunge on the grass or in show rings. See Farm Map.

CLASSES

HTAP- If you are showing an eligible Thoroughbred in 2'3-2'6 hunters (Class 80-Modified or Class 90-PreChild/Adult) or 0.85m Schooling Jumpers (Class 181), you must sign up for the companion HTAP class in order to be eligible for prize money. Use Class numbers: Hunters=Class 500 and Jumpers=Class 501. \$5 fee per class. More info can be found at <http://www.rphsa.com/htap.html>

TIP/Thoroughbred Incentive Program- you must obtain a TIP identification number for your horse to be eligible for up to two high point awards (Hunter High Point 2'6 and above; Hunter High Point below 2'6; and Jumper High Point. Each TIP entry is only eligible for one hunter award per show.

TIP- email TIP # to melissamae33@hotmail.com with rider name and explain which division(s) you have entered at Horse Spot for high point:

- Hunter high point (high 2'6 or higher) Class 600
- Hunter high point (low under 2'6) Class 601
- Jumper high point (all heights) Class 602

Stake classes- Riders must enter one, non-stake class at the same height in order to be eligible for stake class prize money.

1.0M Mini Prix is open to professionals, amateurs and juniors.

Jackpot classes include prize money --- 10% of each horse/rider entry fee.

Show management reserves the right to remove classes from the schedule if necessary, starting with any classes marked with an * (ie warm-up).

Derby class jumps may include high/low options, a trot jump, or other natural elements (ie straw bales).

RED PINE FINALS

The top 6 ranked Red Pine member riders (equitation) or horses (hunters/jumpers) in each RP division with the highest year-end point totals after Carriage House Farm's August Red Pine Show are qualified for Red Pine Finals. The 6 finalists will be scored against each other at Red Pine Finals Show in the designated over fences class (score will be taken from specified jumping class of that particular Red Pine division). The Red Pine member with the highest score from that designated class will be crowned Red Pine Finals Champion of the division.

****This is different than Red Pine Year-end Champion because it is the highest points earners competing against each other. ****

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

STEP 1: Check the Red Pine year-end results after Carriage House Farm August Red Pine Show points are added. If you or your horse are ranked in top 6 as of 9/1/26, you are qualified for Red Pine Finals!

STEP 2: When registering for this show using HORSE SPOT, be sure to enter the Red Pine Finals companion class (if ranked in top 6 in your respective division).

****Please note the Red Pine Finals winner may be different than the Red Pine Year-end Champion. Red Pine Year-end Champions are based on final year-end calculations once the season concludes.**

STABLING FEES --- stalls must be cleaned prior to leaving showgrounds

\$165 Weekend Horse/Tack Stall

\$50 stall cleaning fee (if not cleaned before leaving showgrounds)

\$90 Day stall; limited availability, no overnight.

Shavings per \$11/bag.

Small square hay is \$12/small square (subject to change based on availability)

Showing off your trailer is granted on case-by-case basis—please contact Missy to discuss.

OFFICE/SHOW FEES

Method of payments include: Credit card (4.0% convenience fee), cash or check.

All horses will be charged a one-time schooling fee of \$30.

Medic fee is \$15 per horse.

When you complete your online entries at HORSE SPOT, your credit card will be charged a \$50 deposit fee (plus 4.0% convenience fee).

Office fee- \$30 per horse; late entry fee is \$40 per horse (on or after September 13th).

Classes- \$30 per hunter/equitation class; \$40 per jumper class. Special classes vary; entry fee will be posted at [HORSE SPOT](#)

Add/Scratch & Rode-But-Not-Entered fees:

- Day before by 6pm- no charge
- Before 8am on show day (except Sunday)- no charge
- After 8am on show day (except Sunday)- \$10 charge per change
- Rode in class without entering in office- \$20 per class plus class fee

SUNDAY Add-Scratch fees are **not permitted**. All Sunday classes must be entered on Saturday by 6pm. No refunds for classes scratched on Sunday. If a rider enters Sunday class without entering, there will be \$20/fee per class plus cost of class entry fee.

RPHSA non-member fee \$10 per rider

Fee for a non-showing horse is \$60 per day if horse is not entered in 2 or more classes each day.

CAMPING:

Camper curfew is dark (9:30pm)---all visitors under 18 yrs old must be at their camp site by this time.

- Electric/water hook-up fee is \$150. Dry camping fee is \$50 per weekend.
- If you rent a camper from a 3rd party, you must meet the party and coordinate parking. If the show office has to assist in directing your camper to its space, you will be charged \$50 parking fee. A map of assigned camping spaces will be emailed by September 21st.

PERSONAL GOLF CARTS

Golf cart drivers must have valid state issued license. Participants may bring their own golf carts. However, no electric carts are allowed unless you have a generator---they cannot be plugged into barn or camper outlets. No 4-wheelers or all-terrain vehicles (i.e., side-by-side) are allowed on the property.

RENTED GOLF CARTS

Weekend rental rate is \$350. Unfortunately show management is unable to take requests for 2-seater vs 4-seater. Golf cart vendors are very difficult to secure and show mgmt. takes whatever inventory the vendor has available. If you commit to a golf cart, you will be charged.

Golf cart drivers must have valid state issued license.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

OFFICE FEE:

- Cancellation by September 12th will incur a non-refundable \$50 fee (plus credit card convenience fee)

STABLING/CAMPING:

- Full stabling refunds will be given until entries close.
- Once entries close, no refunds will be given for any reason. (Vet or otherwise).
- Rider(s) may substitute an alternate horse.

SHOW SCRATCHES:

- Between 9/13 and 9/21, scratches will incur the \$30 office fee plus all stabling fees. Credit card on file will be charged unless other arrangements are made with show secretary.
- From 9/22 until end of show, scratched horses will be charged the office fee and all applicable stabling/bedding/hay, and camping fees.

Entry refunds resulting from the cancellation/rescheduling of classes due to extreme weather or an act of God, may be given only at the sole discretion of show management.

MISCELLANEOUS

Food service is available onsite Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Barns close at 9pm each evening.

No mounted riding on property until you have signed a release in the show office and receive an entry number. Numbers must be worn when riding on the grounds at any time.

Be prepared for no cell service. OCF's Wi-Fi is spotty and does not work beyond office area.

ABSOLUTELY NO JUMPING ANY CROSS-COUNTRY FENCES!!!! Any person who jumps cross country jumps without permission will be asked to leave the farm immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS. However, trail riding for all riders is permitted (and encouraged!) and riding horses through water complex is acceptable.

GENERAL RULES & SPECIFICATIONS

RPHSA follows the rules and practices as set forth by the United States Equestrian Federation. It is suggested you have access and familiarity with the USEF rulebook. In the event of a protest or discrepancy, it is recommended that the RPHSA representative(s) at the show make a ruling. This is to be first the secretary, then the show manager.

Horse welfare concerns are to be immediately disclosed to the horse show secretary. Horses entered in the show are limited to either 2 hunter divisions per day (maximum 6 per day). Exceptions may be allowed for W/T and crossrails. Jumper classes are limited to 4 classes per day per horse.
