

# GOLDEN GATE EQUESTRIAN CENTER Red Pine Hunter-Jumper Horse Show

June 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026

RPHSA is looking forward to our first show of the 2026 season at GGEC in Jordan, MN. Farm address is 4125 Country Trail West, Jordan MN 55352.

Here are a few important things to know.

**VACCINATIONS & COGGINS:** All horses visiting the farm must have a negative Coggins within the past 12 months and **flu/rhino vaccination** within the past 6 months (but not less than 2 wks before show date). You **must** provide a **copy** of both records to the show office before unloading your horse.

**ENTRIES close June 13th**, or before, if full. Late entries will be accepted if space allows.

Arrival- please do not arrive on the farm before 6:00am each show day.

## STABLING

**\*IMPORTANT\*** If you need a stall, you must email or text Missy 763-350-9237 to reserve. You will **not** have a stall unless you or your trainer contact Missy. Any riders who receive a stall must register at [HORSE SPOT](#) within 1 week of reserving stall in order to keep reservation. Otherwise, the stall is released to next person on waiting list.

Cost of stabling per day is \$70/day (1 bags of shavings is required).

Overnight stall is additional \$20 and allows you to arrive the night before you show. Horses using overnight stabling option cannot arrive before 6pm. Limited tack stalls may be available after stabling requests are fulfilled.

There is a \$25 stabling admin charge to credit card on file (plus card service fee) if stall is canceled *and* stall can be resold.

## SHOW RINGS & SCHEDULE

SCHOOLING may be available on Thursday and Friday evening from 4-7pm. Please confirm with Missy (763.350.9237 or [melissamae33@hotmail.com](mailto:melissamae33@hotmail.com)) to confirm. Schooling area is always available for hacking in evenings.

FRI/SAT/SUN MORNING SCHOOLING is available from 6:30am until 30 min prior to classes starting in each ring.

Three show arenas: (1) Main ring (sand), (2) Ring #2 (sand) and (3) Indoor Ring

## FRIDAY/SATURDAY HUNTER SCHEDULE:

**The same hunter show schedule will be used FRIDAY and SATURDAY.** Horse cannot enter same division on both Friday and Saturday.

Walk-trot will be held in Indoor Arena. After walk-trot is finished, judge will move to Ring #2 for crossrails and 2' classes. All 2'3 to 3 ft classes will be held in Main Ring.

Management reserves the right to cancel warm-up classes offered for any division.

### **SUNDAY JUMPER SCHEDULE:**

Crossrail, 0.65m and 0.75m Jumper classes will be held in Ring #2. All other jumper classes, 0.85m and up, will be held in Main Ring.

*\*SHOW MGMT RESERVES RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY AND ADJUST SCHEDULE AS NEEDED AND BASED ON ENTRIES\**

Schooling should be available each morning before show- rings open at 6:30am; rings close 30 min before classes begin in each ring. Schooling during show will be available in designated arena---see Farm map.

NO LUNGING IN SHOW RINGS (at any time) OR SCHOOLING ARENAS (during show day). Please use designated lunging area---see Farm map.

### **CLASSES**

HTAP- If you are showing an eligible Thoroughbred in 2'3-2'6 hunters (Class 81 or 91) or 0.85m Schooling Jumpers (Class 181), you must sign up for the companion HTAP class (\$10) in order to be eligible for prize money. Use the following class numbers: Hunters=Class 500SAT and Jumpers=Class 501. More info can be found at <https://www.rphsa.com/htap>

TIP/Thoroughbred Incentive Program- you must obtain a TIP identification number for your horse to be eligible for up to two high point awards (Hunter High Point 2'6 and above; Hunter High Point below 2'6; and Jumper High Point. Each TIP entry is only eligible for one hunter award per show.

TIP- email to [melissamae33@hotmail.com](mailto:melissamae33@hotmail.com) the TIP # and rider name and explain which division(s) you have entered at Horse Spot for high point:

- Hunter high point (high 2'6 or higher) Class 600
- Hunter high point (below 2'6) Class 601
- Jumper high point (all heights) Class 602

Stake classes- Riders must enter one, non-stake class at the same height in order to be eligible for a stake class.

Riders who enter a class without registering in show office will be charged \$20 plus class entry fee.

Professionals are not eligible to show in any Equitation, Medal classes or Adult 0.75m or 0.85m Jumper classes.

There is a two-minute empty gate rule in effect. After two minutes, class will close.

## **FEES**

- PAYMENT options: Credit card (4.0% fee), cash or check.
- When you complete your online entries at [HORSE SPOT](#), your credit card will hold your reservation but will not be charged until the weekend of the horse show. Cancellation or no-show will incur a non-refundable \$30 office fee, not including any reserved stabling charges. The credit card on file will be charged unless other arrangements are made with show secretary.
- Stall fees- see STABLING section above. Shavings \$11/bag. No hay available.
- Office fee- \$30 per horse
- Late entry fee is \$40 per horse.
- Classes- \$30 per hunter/equitation class; \$40 per jumper class; specialty classes vary and cost will be posted at [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com)
- Add Scratch fees: After 8am on day of Show \$10 per change; day before show-no charge
- RPHSA non-member fee \$10 per rider
- Fee for a non-showing horse is \$75 per show day if not entered in 2 or more classes each day.
- Prize money is forfeited if entry closes account in show office before results are entered in horse show management system.
- Returned checks /other non-negotiable payment = \$50 fee charged

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

Food will be available onsite Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

No camping onsite without permission from show management; must have a generator and not require electricity.

No dogs on property unless show management has granted special permission.

No farrier or vet onsite.

### **REFUNDS:**

Office Fee: \$30 is non-refundable once a horse is entered.

Stabling: No refunds for stabling fees 2 weeks prior to start of show---no exceptions including vet note. If you reserved a stall and cancel within 2 weeks of show, you will be charged. However, show management will make every effort to sell your stall/bedding to next person on waiting list. If stall is re-sold, you will only be charged a \$25 stabling admin cancellation fee.

Entry refunds resulting from the cancellation/rescheduling of classes due to extreme weather or an act of God, may be given only at the sole discretion of show management.

## **GENERAL RULES & SPECIFICATIONS**

RPHSA follows the rules and practices as set forth by the United States Equestrian Federation wherever possible. It is suggested you have access and familiarity with the USEF rulebook. In the event of a protest or discrepancy, it is recommended that the RPHSA representative(s) at the show make a ruling. This is to be first the secretary, then the show manager.

Horse welfare issues are to be brought immediate to the horse show secretary. Horses entered in show are limited to either 2 hunter and/or equitation divisions per day (ie 2 divisions per day) or 4 jumper classes per day.
